

Continuing Education Course Description

Vascular Interventional:

The total length of the VI course is 9 months. This will include both classroom and clinical components. The class is hybrid style, it will meet Thursday nights from 5:30p-7:30p at Bon Secours St. Mary's Hospital as well as online. Clinical time is offered during daytime hours and may vary depending on the clinic site. **There is a minimum requirement to complete 24 hours of clinical time per week.** Clinical experience is geared to provide an opportunity to earn competencies for ARRT certification in Vascular Interventional Radiography. There is **no guarantee** of completion of all ARRT requirements. Competency completion is heavily dependent upon clinical volume and intern motivation. The course is designed to instruct technologists on theory and processes used in VI. Course space is limited. There are **no clinical only** options available.
